Concept – The Letter “B”	Class Description – Preschool at home	Date of Lesson – Week of Sept 26th

Lesson Importance – To learn multiple ways in which the letter B can appear.

Prior Knowledge Assessment – The ABC’s can be sung, understands that there are individual letters that make up the alphabet.

Balls/Balloons

- Blow lots of balloons the night before for a surprise when student wakes
- Gather all the balls in the house and talk about how they bounce, and their different sizes
- Get outside – play catch and kick the balls around.
- Glue happy face “ball” stickers to letter B
